LE CHAT PERCHÉ, HOLIDAYS ON A "FARM"

Donkeys, chickens, geese and a cat...there is no doubt that you are at the «Chat Perché» in Allemond. This former farmhouse has two flats that can sleep 4 people each. Le Vieux Moulin and La Belle Étoile are havens of peace for real holidays: sheets and household linen are provided, as is cleaning at the end of the stay. But above all, guests can request breakfast or an evening meal, made with locally-sourced ingredients and prepared by the owner of the house. Le Chat Perché is ideally

situated for hiking to Alpe d'Huez or Oz 3300 thanks to the cable car from Allemond. For those who want to cool off, the Lac du Verney and its water sports centre is a great place to chill out.




📍 AURIS-EN-OISANS

2 ROUTES TO LEARN ABOUT THE AURIENCHONS

The Aurienchons are the inhabitants of Auris-en-Oisans who populated (and still populate) the ten hamlets around the resort. In the old days, they got around using arduous, winding paths. The two orienteering routes offer holidaymakers the chance to follow in the footsteps of these ancestors; to learn about how they used to live, the chapels, oratories and schools that were central to life in the hamlets, by answering the questions on the sheet provided by the tourist office. The first route is called «The hamlets of Les Cours/Châtains» and is an easy 4.5 km trail with 13 markers to be found and a 250 m height gain. The second, «La Balme/ Les Certs», is shorter (3 km) and involves finding 14 markers. This 90-minute walk with a 180 m height gain is a real delight. Free of charge.

BIVOUACKING IN THE WILD, BACK TO BASICS

Bivouacking marks a return to the roots of mountaineering adventures. In the Pilatte valley, a magnificent high mountain site that flirts with glaciers and eternal snow, participants hike along this almost formative path for two memorable days. Accompanied by a high-mountain guide, the group of 3 to 5 people learn how to walk on snowy, rocky or glacial terrain, with or without crampons, as well as rope techniques. The aim is to reach a pass or summit together. The two-day quest includes a night at the Says bivouac spot, a platform where you lay down your sleeping bag for a night under the stars. No better way to admire the Milky Way! A back to basics adventure in the mountains. For fit hikers only.

📍 BESSE-EN-OISANS

TWO DAYS ON HORSEBACK ON THE OISANS STEPPES

There's nothing quite like two days of horse-riding to get away from it all. The adventure starts at 9am from the traditional village of Besse-en-Oisans with its stone houses, and begins with a climb up the GR54. From the saddle, Oisans looks a little like Mongolian steppes, especially when you arrive on the Plateau d'Emparis, a listed «Natura 2000» site on account of its exceptional plant and animal life. The landscape stretches as far as the eye can see, and the ride is punctuated by stops at Lac Lérié and Lac Noir. The landscape seems to go on as far as the eye can see, the walk is punctuated by stops at Lac Lérié and Lac Noir, and views of the mythical Meije, Râteau, Grandes Rousses and Aiguilles d'Arve. The evening halt is at the Fay mountain hut with an opportunity to taste the local speciality, farçis de l'Oisans. The next day, the ride continues towards the foot of the Mas de la Grave before looping back to Besse en Oisans.

REFUGE DE LA FARE, GOOD AND BEAUTIFUL

Perched in mountain pastures at 2,280m in the shelter of the Grandes Rousses massif, halfway between the Lacs Bessons and the Plan des Cavales, this small 12-bed mountain hut blends in with its surroundings. The oldest hut in Oisans has been modernised over the years. Laurence swaps her ski instructor's gear in winter to become the warden of this corner of paradise in summer. She's an outstanding cook and makes a point of using local products, even for the trail snacks. A BBQ evening is held once a week, facing the sunset over the Massif de Belledonne. It's an opportunity to chat about the day's hike or climb while sipping a cold beer in a deckchair. Life at its best!

EASY TOUR DES LACS: FROM LAC BESSON TO LAC CARRELET

This is an easy walk to do with the family that is sure to offer a change of scenery. At over 2000 m, this plateau of the Petites Rousses creates a mineral atmosphere. From the car park, a short climb allows you to admire Lac Besson, the first of the day's lakes. After returning down the same path, the real route begins by taking the path that leads to Lac Noir, where the panoramic view is reflected in the dark water. Then follow the GR549, cross peat bogs in a protected environment, to reach Lac Faucille and then Lac Carrelet. The walk is almost 7 km long, with barely 145 m of ascent to be tackled. The mountains open up onto the valley, offering magnificent views. The walk should take 2h30 with good shoes.

CROQ'OISANS, HIKING WITH GOOD COMPANY

Jean-Marc Giraud has spent over 17 years on trails, with his job as a trek leader taking him from the French mountain ranges to far-flung horizons, but it is in Oisans that he has set up his «base camp», where his family go back 600 years. With the 5-day Croq'Oisans tour, he takes hikers to the heart of the Ecrins National Park with 6-hour days of intense hiking and height gains of between 800 and 1000m. The reward is on the trail and enchantment round every bend.




📍 LES ÉCRINS

THE TOUR DES ÉCRINS, A WALK IN THE WILD

It takes seven days to walk around this massif, the largest in France and one of the last, great unspoilt areas. From Oisans to the Briançonnais via Champsaur-Valgaudemar, the majesty of the route leaves you spellbound, especially when crossing the Muzelle, Aup-Martin or Vallonpierre passes. The views embrace summits such as the Meije, the Pelvoux and the Écrins. Eagles, vultures, ibexes, chamois - wildlife can be seen by those who know how to watch with respect. 7,800m of height gain, 7,300m of height loss and 6 nights in huts, this is an intense adventure that can be enjoyed alone or with a guide.

TWO-DAY HIKE WITH YOUR OWN DONKEY

Their big, soft ears and gentle eyes delight children...and their parents. Much more docile than many people expect, the donkeys accompany hikers for two days through Oisans. Fitted with a pack-saddle, they carry the bags and occasionally help with tired small legs. These two unique days start in Saint-Christophe-en-Oisans and cover 14 km in the Vénéon valley, with 950m height gain for a total of 9 hours' walking. On the first day, hikers go through the hamlets of Le Puy, Les Fétoules, Cuculet and Pré Clot, before reaching the Gite des Arias, in the middle of nowhere. The second day takes hikers into the high mountains to reach La Bérarde, with its iconic Alpine summits.

TWO GREENWAYS FOR OFF-ROAD CYCLING IN OISANS

Open only to non-motorised vehicles, the greenways are a haven of peace for cycling, walking, inline skating or other motor-free vehicles!

> The Via Chambon is a 5.3km greenway that provides a safe route between Isère and the Hautes-Alpes! Initially used as a back-up road, this greenway provides exceptional views of the Lac du Chambon and the surrounding mountains. For athletic cyclists, it's the ideal way to reach the most beautiful passes in the region, such as the Lautaret and Galibier. Two car parks and a bus service from Grenoble provide easy access.

Open from the beginning of May to the end of October, depending on the snow cover.

> Starting in Allevard, passing through Le Bourg-d'Oisans and on to the craft village of Venosc, this greenway is over 25 km long. You can cycle or walk along this virtually flat «backbone», but you can also veer off into one or more of the 6 Oisans valleys. Tackle the switchbacks up to Alpe d'Huez, climb up to the Col d'Ornon, take a refreshing break at the Pisse waterfall or enjoy a gentle ride along the glacier-blue Vénéon River.

THE BLACK GARDEN A NEW MTB TRACK

Already boasting a bike park that would make many resorts pale in comparison, Les 2 Alpes is revamping its mountain bike area (one of the largest in the Alps), working alongside mountain bike pros such as Adrien Loron (the new mountain biking ambassador for Les 2 Alpes). Several improvements are scheduled for the summer of 2023, including a brand new track, called Black Garden. This black track, clearly designed for experienced riders, will also run to the village of Venosc below the resort and provide mountain bikers with an alternative to the current red track (very busy because it is so popular!). In all, a 1.8 km and 500 m descent through the woods for a lovely adrenaline-filled challenge!



THE PATH UP TO THE COL DU COUARD, NOT FOR THE FAINT-HEARTED!

Hikers can immerse themselves in the high mountains thanks to this technical route featuring glacial lakes and snow-covered peaks. There are two possible options: a challenging full-loop version that can be completed in a day, starting from Vaujany and heading straight for the Col du Couard before moving on to an easier section on the Plan des Cavalles, overlooked by the highest peaks in the massif and their glaciers, which can be admired in all their beauty. Stop at the Lac de la Fare and the Rajon shelter, before heading back down. The second option is a lighter hike starting at the top of the cable car, which starts with a flat section, before climbing up to the pass and continuing along the same route as described above. In both cases, this beautiful hike is for good hikers who can manage 7 hours of walking and 1350 m of ascent.

UNIQUE, THE TINY REFUGE DES SOURCES, BACK TO BASICS



Hiking up to the Refuge des Sources is like going back to the earliest times of mountain shelters. Rustic and rudimentary, with a door and roof designed to withstand the snowy winters, this hut provides 6 mattresses, blankets, a table and two benches. You have to bring your own stove and food. It's hard to get much closer to the bare essentials! But the charm works, after 800 m of ascent devoured in 2h30, at 2 268 m, this small hut is paradise for those who have come to seek silence, beauty and introspection in the mountains.

NEW: LE CHAMP DE PIN, A COSY MOUNTAIN HOTEL & RESTAURANT

«Le Champ de Pin» is synonymous with calm, rest and switching off. Just outside the iconic village of La Bérarde, the Oisans mountaineering mecca, the hotel, bar & restaurant have been completely renovated. Its 7 rooms are unique, decorated in a contemporary wooden style that gives pride of place to stone and natural materials. They are all located on the ground floor, with outside access and a small terrace. The restaurant and bar are open all day, serving quick meals to passing hikers and mountaineers, and in the evenings to hotel guests and food lovers with refined, gourmet dishes made with fresh, local produce. 

VULTURE COUNT DAY ON 22 JULY 2023

Lovers of birds, and especially vultures, also love counting them! A single summer's day is dedicated to this survey and this year it's on 22 July from 1.30 pm to 8 pm. Under the national impetus of the LPO (League for the Protection of Birds), the Montagnes et Sciences association is organising this count with the managers of protected areas in France (Ecrins National Park) in order to gather scientific data about these vulnerable species and to better understand their conservation. After a 1.5 hour walk up to the counting stations, participants look for species in flight and on the ground, then monitor the numbers according to the counting protocol before compiling the data in the evening at the mountain hut. The start is from the Perrons car park in Clavans




CANI-HIKING, DOGS ARE A HI- KER'S BEST FRIEND



Cécile Andrieux used to be an engineer, before turning her hand to farming in the mountains in 2016. She took on the crazy challenge of growing plants in Villard-Reymond, at an altitude of 1650m, without chemicals and in an environment that is as preserved and diversified as possible. After making biscuits and meringues, she started growing genepi, which she now turns into liqueur. Growing genepi, a wild plant par excellence, requires a lot of work and weeding, for an early harvest at the end of May... But it's all worth it, as the nectar is delicious. She uses organic grain alcohol, organic beet sugar, water from the village spring, sprigs of génépi, and that's it! It is then sold directly from the farm, at markets and in local produce shops. DECARBONATING THE LOCAL AREA AND PROVIDING AN ALTERNATIVE TO CARS



Free shuttles linking Venosc (Les 2 Alpes) to the Hydrélec Museum in Le Verney (Vaujany) are available for exploring Oisans, thanks to the initiative of the Oisans Community of Municipalities and the Auvergne Rhône-Alpes Region. This 47-seat shuttle has a bicycle trailer, runs 7 days a week and is accessible to people with reduced mobility.

There are 10 stops: Les 2 Alpes via the Venosc cable car, Les Ougiers, Le Clapier d'Auris, Bourg d'Oisans (Rond-point de Sarenne), Bourg d'Oisans (Gare Routière), Bourg d'Oisans (La Paute), Bourg d'Oisans (Eglise des Sables), Bourg d'Oisans (Rochetaillée), Allemond (Eau d'Olle Express), Vaujany (Le Verney, Musée Hydrélec).

HÔTEL DE MILAN, SECOND-HAND DESIGN

This is one of the oldest hotels in the valley, built in 1936 and renovated in 2017. The 17 rooms have gradually been refurbished and 9 beautiful apartments created. But what makes the Hotel de Milan so special is that the restoration has kept the family spirit while adding a touch of modernity... with furniture that the owner has found second-hand and restored with taste! Here, no room has the same decoration and each space has a tale to tell. The barn in the extensive grounds hides an artwork cellar used for wine tasting evenings and a sauna is located on the pontoon by the river. As it is in Oisans, the home of the bicycle, the hotel also has garages and repair workshops, much appreciated by cyclists.

VALLEY LIFTS, ENVIRONMEN- TALLY-FRIENDLY TRAVEL

Valley lifts are a soft mobility solution to reduce traffic and provide a fast and environmentally friendly link between the valley and the altitude resorts. They encourage changes in travel behaviour, with the goal of achieving «zero carbon» mountains. Oisans hosts two valley lifts: the Eau d'Olle Express, which links Allemond to Alpe d'Huez Grand Domaine in 8 minutes, and the Venosc cable car which goes to Les 2 Alpes, also in 8 minutes. These lifts allow visitors to enjoy village life in the valley and then to go for a walk up in the mountains without taking their car.

→ New: Oz 3300 now boasts a new pedestrian lift, linking the top of the valley lift to the resort centre.

BY ROAD

→ Motorway from Paris, Lyon, Marseille and Geneva to Grenoble. From Grenoble, follow "Sisteron/Gap" on the A480 motorway, taking Exit 8 «Vizille - Stations de l'Oisans». Then follow the N85 until Vizille, then the D1091 signposted Briançon.

→ Bourg d'Oisans is 50 km from Grenoble. A 45-min drive from Exit 8.

BY PLANE


→ Grenoble - Isère airport, 91 km from Bourg d'Oisans

→ Lyon Saint Exupéry airport, 139 km from Bourg d'Oisans

BY TRAIN

→ TGV Paris-Grenoble, regular 3-hour connections. Then bus to Bourg d'Oisans and the main Oisans villages, with Transisère (www.transisere.fr) and Lignes Express Régionales (www.bus-et-clic.com/ler35)

→ Geneva International airport, 192 km from Bourg d'Oisans



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
