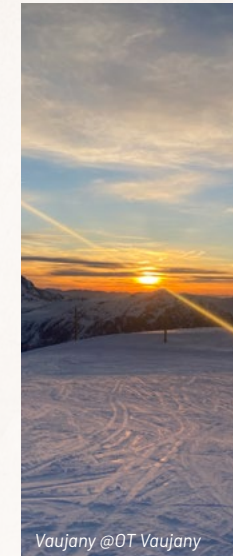

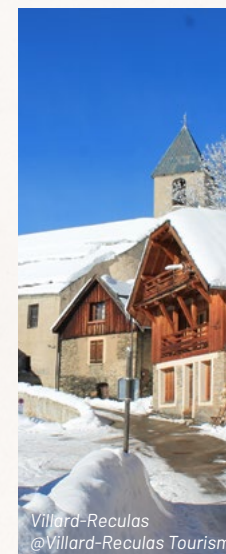

OISANS RECORDS

📍 AURIS-EN-OISANS

THE HIGHEST SPRUCE FOREST IN EUROPE IS IN AURIS-EN-OISANS

The Auris-en-Oisans forest zone begins at an altitude of 1,420 m and peaks at 1,780 m. Spruce is the dominant species, but it shares its terrain with fir, Scots pine and European larch. This beautiful forest, where a few deciduous trees have also taken root, turns a beautiful colour in autumn. But beyond its beauty, its primary virtues are its role in protecting the environment, preventing soil erosion and protecting roads and hamlets from avalanches and mudslides. If they're lucky, walkers can spot roe deer, wild boar, hares, foxes, badgers and partridges.

FRANCE'S LARGEST ICE SHEET IS IN OISANS

The Écrins National Park, which rises to 4,101 m at the Barre des Écrins, is one of France's largest glacier reserves in the Alps. The Girose and Mont-de-Lans glaciers, which lie next to each other, cover a distance of 6 km from east to west. This fragile natural area needs protecting!

📍 LES DEUX ALPES

THE BIGGEST VERTICAL DESCENT ON A SKI AREA (2,300 M) IS IN LES DEUX ALPES

From the glacier at 3,568 m, skiers can embark on a breathtaking descent down to the resort. This takes them through the entire ski area from its highest point to the village of Mont-de-Lans. It can be a test of fitness for skiers who don't stop, or a journey of contemplation for those who take a few breaks. The scenery of Oisans and its peaks is well worth the effort.

📍 ALPE D'HUEZ

THE LONGEST BLACK RUN IN EUROPE IS IN ALPE D'HUEZ

It's 16 km long, black, called the Sarenne and it's the longest run in Europe. Physical, demanding and fast, with a few nice little bumps, it starts at the summit of the Pic Blanc at 3,300 m, the resort's landmark peak, and finishes in the valley below Auris-en-Oisans. Skiers leave the resort far behind and enjoy breathtaking untamed mountain scenery. The descent can be tackled at night on certain dates during the season.



📍 LE COL D'ORNON

IF YOU'RE LOOKING FOR CALM AND UNSPOILT BEAUTY

What you'll like here is the very small ski area (8 marked runs and 4 ski lifts) and its intimate, unspoilt atmosphere. Children can learn the rudiments of skiing without being disturbed in special areas, under the expert guidance of our pampering instructors! Meanwhile, you can enjoy the slopes on your own, or the magic of the woods and Alpine meadows on snowshoe or Nordic ski trails. What a pleasure to spend your holidays away from the crowds!

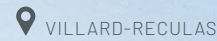

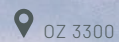

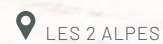
FROM PIC BLANC TO ENVERSin D'OZ: A 2,000 M SKI DESCENT!

At Oz 3300, in an amazing setting, the Pic Blanc stands proud at 3,330 metres. Not only are there breathtaking views, but it's also the start point for a 2,205-metre descent. Imagine skiing for a whole hour without taking a single lift... it's a dream come true in this white wonderland! The runs are of varying difficulty, so skiers enjoy plenty of thrills: starting with the black Tunnel run with its legendary descent, followed by the red Les Rousses and the blue Les Chalets runs. Finally, the black piste at La Fare among the fir trees is a perfect opportunity to enjoy some long, sweeping turns. The long, long descent, with its breathtaking views, ends at Enversin d'Oz, at 1,125 metres. On your marks, get set, ski!

STRUCTURAL AND SUSTAINABLE PROJECTS FOR THE NEXT 50 YEARS

The resort of Les 2 Alpes is pursuing ambitious development projects, not only to modernise the resort and make it more comfortable, but above all to ensure that the mountains are accessible to everyone, for all types of activity and in all four seasons. The big news is that the Jandri Express gondola, which takes skiers from the resort at 1,600 m to the summit at 3,200 m, will be replaced by a 3S cable car. This will be more comfortable, better able to cope with weather conditions, halve the number of pylons to reduce visual impact, and take 15

minutes instead of 40. The new Jandri 3S will be ready in December 2024. In the Vallée Blanche, the flow of passengers will be doubled, up to an altitude of 2,100 m: pedestrians, skiers and beginners will now have access to the new green run in less than 5 minutes. And the snow front is also getting a makeover, with various improvements ensuring that skiers are better spread along the central area, making it easier to learn to ski.

AN INTRODUCTION TO ICE CLIMBING

You may think that ice climbing is out of your reach or just for the most adventurous and experienced mountaineers... But the Alpe d'Huez Guides' Office begs to differ! As part of its drive to help people explore everything the mountains have to offer, the Bureau des Guides is organising ice-climbing courses for beginners. They head for the Cascade de la Fare: a gem of a frozen waterfall, located in the heart of a peaceful, unspoilt area. Access is via the «DMC 1» cable car on touring skis, before gradually entering the world of mountaineering. It takes an hour to reach the icefall, where you can practise using crampons and ice axes in complete safety. Ski touring, climbing, abseiling and returning on skis all add up to an exciting programme for the day.

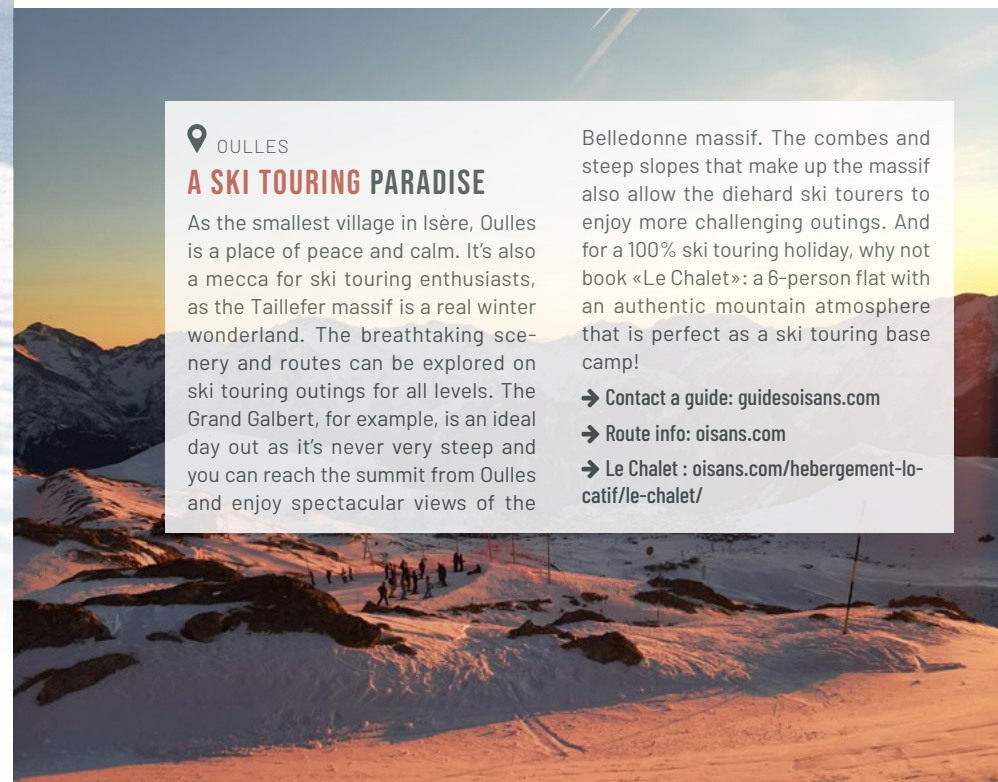

In the last rays of sunlight, they share a snack made from local produce, learn about the work of the ski patrollers and take in the scenery all around them... This unique experience ends with a long descent on skis with headtorches, in the peace and quiet of the surroundings, back to the resort of Vaujany.

So small families (4 people) should head to the Refuge de l'Ourson, and larger families (15 people) to the Tanière de l'Ours. This accommodation, located in the heart of the small family ski resort of Col d'Ornon, is perfect for a winter sports holiday. Enjoy cosy winter evenings after days in the snow, and savour the comfort of these chalets. The added bonus is the gondola from the old Vaujany ski lift in the garden, which means that when night falls, you can curl up among the sheepskins and cosy cushions, in the warm lights, and enjoy an unforgettable raclette or fondue evening...

LA GRAVE ...SWITCHING OFF AT THE REFUGE DE CHAMOISSIÈRE



This authentic chalet hut is located at 2,106 m among the Villar-d'Arène mountain pastures and at the foot of the glaciers. A former sheepfold, it has been renovated in a cosy style, with recycled roof timbers and in a building refurbished using eco-friendly materials (lime, larch and hemp, old wood and centuries-old metal). As it has 220 V electricity, the hut is self-sufficient for 3 days thanks to its photovoltaic panels and a 400 W wind turbine. Photothermal panels provide hot water for the showers and heating, ensuring guests stay comfortable. They are also encouraged to switch off as there is no network in the hut. No 4G, no Wi-Fi, so talk to each other! A sign says in the dining room. A welcome return to conversation away from screens!

What's more, for total peace of mind, the area is completely enclosed and a host of services are still available, including electric hook-ups, toilet blocks with heated showers and a chemical toilet for emptying waste water tanks. 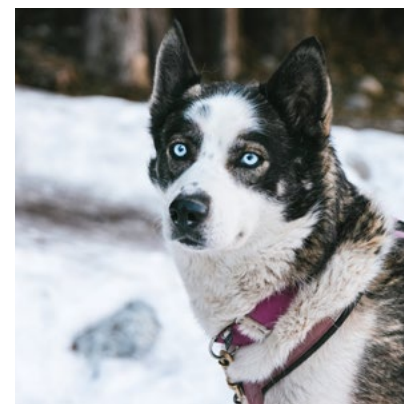

The Vaujany ESF supports sport for everyone. With a view to teaching para-skiing to as many people as possible, the ski school has invested in high-performance equipment and has begun training 8 instructors. The aim is to enable everyone to ski as a family and to train people to ski independently, as well as helping those accompanying them to manage the equipment.

FREE SHUTTLES TO EXPLORE OISANS, SKI IN ALL THE RESORTS AND MEET LOCAL ARTISANS

Oisans is a very diverse area, offering a wide range of experiences for holiday-makers. Skiing, of course, but also mountain activities and visits to villages. In winter, taking the car can be a nuisance, especially when you have to shovel snow! Oisans has thought of everything by setting up free shuttles to link the valleys: from Venosc village (and Les 2 Alpes via the cable car) to Bourg-d'Oisans, as well as to the Eau d'Olle valley at Allemond (Oz 3,300 and Alpe d'Huez via the Eau d'Olle Express lift) and Vaujany. The shuttle runs 7 days a week and has a ski trailer so you can ski in the resorts without taking your car, visit the villages and meet the 45 artisans and visit the museums on the Oisans Savoir-faire Route.

📍 VALLÉE DU FERRAND

CHALET DE LA BOIRE, IN THE MIDDLE OF NOWHERE

Chalet de la Boire is one of the most magical places in Oisans. This 6-bed former mountain pasture chalet clings to the mountainside at an altitude of 1,900 m, opposite the peaks, making it a delight to laze around on the south-facing terrace. In winter, only ski tourers and snowshoe trekkers have access. This amazing place has been ecologically renovated using local wood, ecological insulation materials, dry toilets, renewable energy thanks to solar panels (12 V electricity) and hot water depending on the amount of sunshine! For cooking, you have to rely on the wood-burning range (or use the gas cooker, of course!) and for water, you either have to melt the snow or bring your own bottled water. The owner, who is a trek leader, can accompany you to the refuge on snowshoes.

📍 VILLARD-REYMOND

A SINGLE SKI LIFT IN THE VILLAGE, MADE FROM RECYCLED MATERIALS AND RUN BY VOLUNTEERS

This little hilltop village lives peacefully to the rhythm of the seasons. At its highest point is a ski lift covering 40 metres of ungroomed snow, which is like a giant piece of mecano, created by assembling spare parts from resorts in the Vercors and Oisans. The parts were assembled by volunteers from Le Renouveau, the association that now runs it, with the help of the STRMTG (the body responsible for checking the safety of ski lifts and conveyor belts in mountain resorts) to ensure compliance with safety standards. For their part, the villagers run the lift on a voluntary basis alongside Jacques, who has been operations manager for the last 10 years, and Olivier, his deputy, who also runs the Gîte de l'Eau Blanche. There is a €7 charge for each day the lift is open, to help fund the future creation of cross-country ski trails.

→ Bourg-d'Oisans is 50 km from Grenoble and 45 minutes from exit 8.

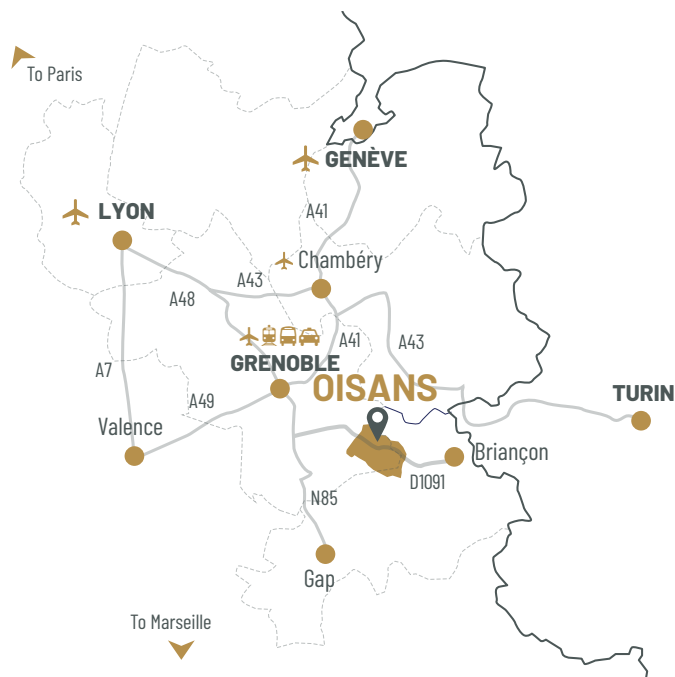
